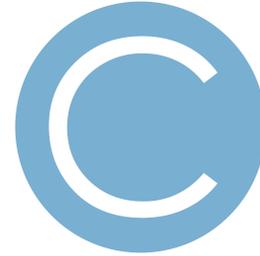


DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

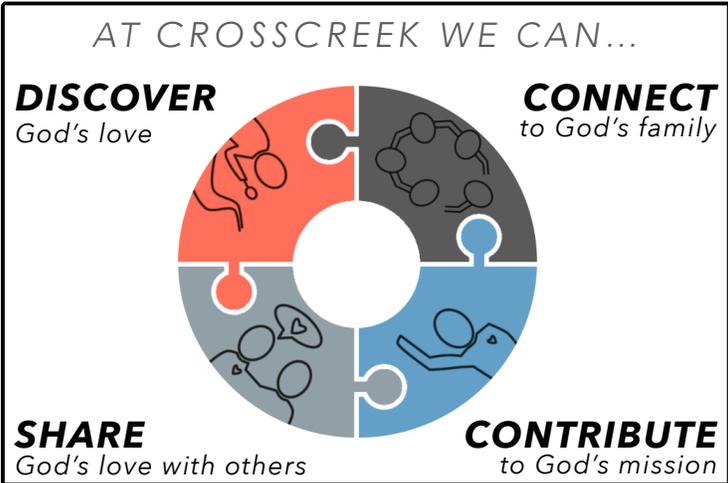
