Main Points (Luke 10:25-37)

All of your conflicts have one thing in common... YOU.

Nothing ruins relationships faster than selfishness.

If God answered all of your prayers with YES... would anyone else's life be better?

Humility is the path to better relationships.

When you trust God for what you need you don't have to fight for what you want.

Trusting that God is FOR you frees you to be FOR others.

Being FOR others is what will ultimately give you the life you want.

The next time you have conflict with someone stop and say:
"You know what the problem is? I'm not getting what I want."

And Ask two questions...

1. Will I truly be happy if I win this argument?
2. Would I have to fight if I KNEW God was FOR me?

The relationships you've always wanted begin with your choices today.

Together we can be FOR Salem.

Discussion Questions

1. All around us are messages to put ourselves first. What saying/quote, ad, or song comes to mind as an example?
2. In your life have you seen selfishness/self-centeredness be at the root of most of your conflict? If not, has it been something else? Can you think of any examples?
3. What is a practical way you can be FOR the people you are closest to look right now?
