Main Points

What is the Church FOR?

The Church was created to show the world that God is FOR them.

The church (ekklesia) exists FOR everyone.

Ekklesia: called out.

Invitation: One action this week that shows someone you are FOR them.

A Jesus Follower is "called out" to reflect God's love.

The church is not somewhere you go... it's something you <u>are</u>.

The church isn't just for church people... the church is FOR the world because God is for the world.
