Main Points - Genesis 39-50

The unknown disrupts everything that we think we know.

We have a choice with what we do in the unknown.

1. Fight it. 2. Do nothing. 3. Lovingly act.

Fighting the unknown causes destruction, pain, and loss.

Doing nothing does nothing.

Loving action has amazing results.

Trusting God leads to loving action.

You can choose to engage the unknown by “lovingly acting” and being FOR others.

In the unknown, we can choose to trust God and lovingly act.

1. When faced with an unknown situation how do you USUALLY tend to react: fight it, do nothing, lovingly act? Why? How do you know what approach to take to a situation and when?
2. Read Phil 2:3-8. What here do you think most relates to “trusting God and lovingly acting”?
