Main Points - Matthew 28:16-20

Fear of the unknown affects everything we know.

A clear purpose provides a path through the hazy unknown.

The first step into the unknown is trust.

Trust clarifies our purpose.

A purpose that is bigger than us removes the fear of what the unknown will take away from us.

You are invited: to trust, to purpose.

A purpose bigger than you provides a path through your big unknowns.

Prayer: Show me how I can be a "blessing person" today.

A clear purpose makes the unknown an adventure to live not a nightmare to fear.
