

Pt 4: It's Dangerous to Go Alone || Episode 29 || October 4, 2020

Main Points

Division creates isolation.

Loneliness isn't about being alone. It's about not being known.

Faith withers in isolation.

Faith is not meant to be lived out alone.

Faith grows in community.

Faith: Choosing to trust that Jesus is who he says he is, and will do what he says he will do.

God doesn't want us to be committed to simply going to a religious service. He wants us to be committed to each other.

Community: Purposely being with people for the purpose of loving and encouraging each other.

You get out of relationships what you put into them.

Facing the real world requires real faith. And real faith requires real community in order to really grow.
