Main Points

When the world is falling apart we prioritize surviving over thriving.

God wants you to be happy.

A happy life is a dependent life.

The path to happiness is often illogical.

Difficulties are opportunities to practice either fear or trust.

If we can trust God with our eternity we can trust him with our now.
