Main Points

Everybody is on a quest for happiness.

Happiness doesn't come from trying to make ourselves happy.

Jesus offers an unending reservoir of happiness.

A happy life is not about me.

Following Jesus isn't just believing... it's doing.

The true test of what we believe is what we do.

Happiness comes from a faith that results in loving others.

If faith doesn't compel us to act out of unconditional love toward others, it is not faith.

Ask yourself two questions...

- 1. Self-Reflection: Is what I believe transforming how I love?
- 2. Real Life Action: What does love look like?
