## Main Points

Much of our conflict comes from our desire to be MORE THAN.

In the Kingdom of God LESS THAN is more powerful than MORE THAN.

We naturally view our lives through a comparison of hierarchy and rank.

We find MORE by choosing to become LESS.

- We find MORE *freedom* in being LESS.
- We find MORE *peace* in being LESS
- We find MORE *purpose* in being LESS.

In the Kingdom of God, LESS THAN is more powerful than we can imagine.

## Message Passage

*About that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Who is greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven?" Jesus called a little child to him and put the child among them. Then he said, "I tell you the truth, unless you turn from your sins and become like little children, you will never get into the Kingdom of Heaven. So anyone who becomes as humble as this little child is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven."*

Matthew 18:1-4 NLT

*Then they began to argue among themselves about who would be the greatest among them. Jesus told them, "In this world the kings and great men lord it over their people, yet they are called 'friends of the people.' But among you it will be different. Those who are the greatest among you should take the lowest rank, and the leader should be like a servant. Who is more important, the one who sits at the table or the one who serves? The one who sits at the table, of course. But not here! For I am among you as one who serves."*
