## Main Points

Many Christians see themselves as the moral police of society.  
Following Jesus isn't about what we should or shouldn't do. It's about WHO you can be and what you can do.  
You can intentionally multiply hope, peace, and love in the world.  
Jesus Followers exist to bring life to the world.  
Jesus didn't intend his followers to be the moral police of the world. He intends his followers to be the light of the world.  
Jesus Followers illuminate who Jesus is.  
Being the light of the world requires intentional prayer, actions and words.  
Loving like Jesus is loving intentionally.  
Intentionally multiplying- We love others, so they can love others, who can then love others.  
You can discover, enjoy, and share the life Jesus offers.

### **\*3 questions to guide us in being the light of the world...**

1. For whom am I intentionally praying?
2. Who am I intentionally loving in order to show the love of God?
3. With whom am I intentionally sharing the life Jesus offers?
